

Instructions for A/V Use

USB Flash Drives for each course can be found in the course binders, and the drives are color coded by course:

- Basic I – **Green**
- Basic II – **Blue**
- Experienced Course – **Red**

Step 1: Plug USB into back of the television, as shown:

Step 2: Power up the television

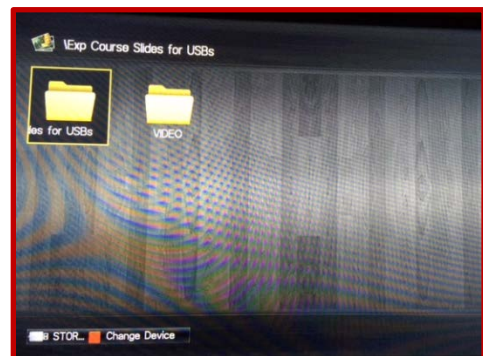
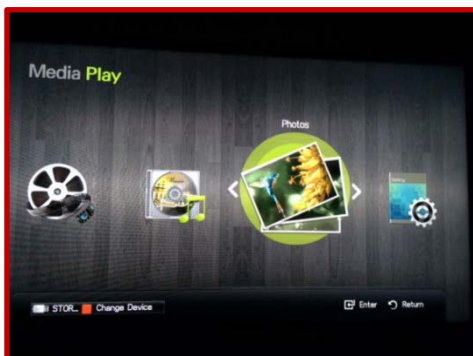


Step 3: Select Media.P on television remote control (it may take a few seconds for the television to recognize the media input – be patient. You may need to hit the Media.P button again if it does not come up the first time.)




Step 4: Use the arrow keys to select “Photos” from the menu screen; Enter

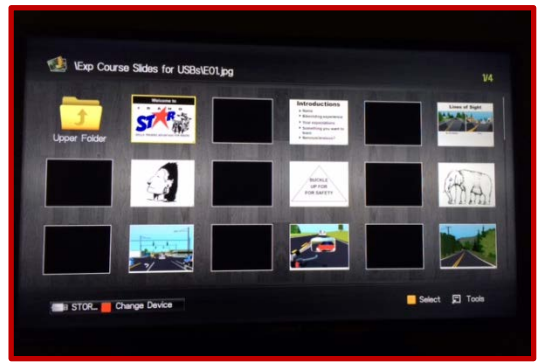
Step 5: At the Photos menu screen, select Slides for USB file; Enter



Step 6: Arrow over to the slide you want to display; Enter

Step 7: Enter again to pause the automatic slideshow advance feature and put it on manual advance mode

Step 8: Use the right arrow key to advance slides 



Step 9: Use the Media.P button to return to the menu for changing to video (you may need to press twice)

Step 10: For Basic I, *Riding Straight* video, select the Riding Straight file; Enter. It should automatically play

For Experienced Course *Do the Test* video, select "Play Video," VIDEO_TS.VOB or VTS_01_1.VOB (either will work); Enter

Step 11: To return to slides, select Media.P; start back at Step 4

Notes:

There is a black slide between each presentation slide for "sleep" mode during discussions.



For Basic I and Basic II SIPDE slides, there are two copies of each SIPDE slide separated by black slides that go in this sequence: show first image for 2 seconds; advance to black for discussion; advance to redisplay image for discussion.

There are "placeholders" for videos and Day 2/Day 3 start points for Basic I for ease of finding your place again after exiting out. These are for Instructor information only and are not meant to be displayed, but if they happen to be, it's okay, don't sweat it.

Remember that the slides will advance automatically unless you press enter to pause the slideshow, which sets it to manual advance.
